UICC Master Courses

Guidelines for Participants

Master Courses are purpose-built educational activities combining an online component with a face-to-face workshop. The tailor-made nature of the content and blended format of delivery makes them a unique platform to meet the specific needs for continuing education of those engaged in cancer control from various disciplines and at different levels.

What is expected from Participants?

Individuals who register to attend the 2020 World Cancer Congress in Oman are eligible to apply, free of charge, for one of the Master Courses on offer. Applications can be made via the Congress registration form starting from late March. Limited places are available on each course, hence selection will take place for over-subscribed courses.

In order to be enrolled on a Master Course, participants must have completed their World Cancer Congress registration, including payment of the Congress registration fee, prior to the start of the Master Courses' online components, and in any case no later than 15 June 2020. This is to ensure that those who access the online course will attend the World Cancer Congress and be present for the one-day interactive workshop on 19 October 2020.

Please note that only participants who complete the online course will be granted permission to attend the face-to-face workshop.

Master Course Participants are expected to:

1. Follow the online course as instructed by the course leaders through webinars, narrated slides and additional reading (the online component of each course has been designed so to be compatible with the busy schedule of full-time employed professionals).
2. Complete any online assignments and quizzes within the specified timeframe.
3. Contribute to online discussions related to the course content with peers via the online discussion forum.
4. Attend and actively participate at the face-to-face workshop on 19 October 2020 in Oman.
5. Complete the evaluation surveys at the beginning and end of the course.
6. Contact your course leader or UICC (education@uicc.org) if you encounter any problems that prevent you from accessing content or completing the course.

Certificates

Certificates will be provided to all participants who follow all steps of the online course, attend the face-to-face workshop and complete the required surveys at the beginning and end of the course.
