Dr. Vijaendreh Subramaniam (Dr. Vijae) is a Senior Consultant Gynae-Oncologist at Mahkota Medical Center, a leading private hospital in Malaysia. He graduated from University of Malaya in 1986 and joined the Ministry of Health Malaysia, where he served for 25 years in various capacities in many different hospitals. He retired as the Head of Department and joined the private sector in 2011.

He commenced postgraduate training in Obstetrics and Gynaecology (O&G) in 1991 working at Raigmore Hospital (NHS), in Scotland and gained a postgraduate qualification in Obstetrics and Gynaecology from the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists (RCOG, UK) in 1994.

Upon returning to Malaysia, he assumed the role of heading the O&G service in the State of Sarawak, spearheading the development of the O&G services in the under served areas of rural Malaysia overseeing 22 Hospitals. He was instrumental in the lowering of the maternal maternity and perinatal mortality rate in the Sate through various groundbreaking initiatives. He was the representative for the RCOG and has trained more than 100 specialists and was also a key member in the inception of the University Malaysia Sarawak's Medical Faculty.

In 2003 he furthered his sub-speciality training in Gynae-Oncology in the UK at the St. Bartholomew Hospital (St. Barts), one of the leading cancer centres in London; in the management of complex gynaecological cancers and advanced gynaecological surgery.

Dr. Vijae is an accomplished surgeon and is trained in Minimally Invasive Surgery (MIS) in gynaecological cancers from the world famous Kurashiki Medical Centre in Japan.

Dr. Vijae has worked in oncology since 1995. He has initiated and established sub-Speciality units (Gynae-Oncology) in 2 major hospitals (Sarawak General Hospital and Melaka General Hospital) and has trained numerous sub-specialists.

For more than 30 years he has also been an avid educator, having trained medical students, specialists in O& G and subspecialists in Gynae-oncology. He was the Honorary Professor (O&G) in Manipal Medical College and University Malaysia Sarawak, Lead Trainer and

Candidate Supervisor for the Masters Programme in Obstetric and Gynaecology U.K.M., U.M. and U.S.M. He has been a visiting consultant in numerous hospitals in Malaysia and has been on the advisory board of various national committee in the development of Obs & Gyn and Gynae-Oncology services.

Since 2011 he has expanded his practice areas to include alternative and complementary modalities in an integrative fashion in the treatment of cancer. He has travelled extensively throughout the world learning and observing first hand from leading practitioners of integrative medicine.
