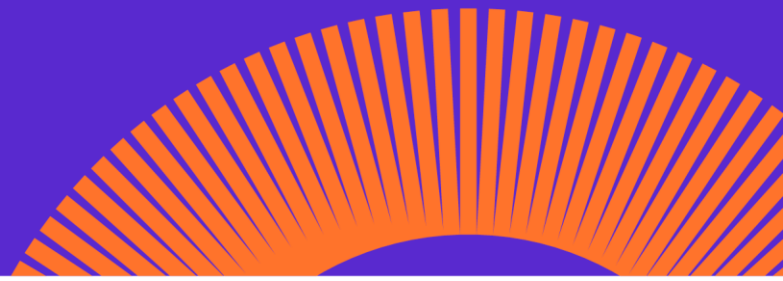

Biography

Thomas Dubois is the Head of European and International Affairs at the French National Cancer Institute (INCa). Under the responsibility of the President and the Director General of INCa, he participates in the elaboration of French positions (follow-up of the European cancer plan, IARC Board of Directors) and coordinates the European and international activities of the Institute. INCa is involved several international cooperation efforts, and in 8 European projects in the fields of translational research, cancer control policies, new generation sequencing for oncology, innovative therapies, tobacco control, prevention, or the establishment of a European network of comprehensive cancer centres and European networks of experts.

He holds a PhD from the Ecole des Hautes Etudes en Sciences Sociales (EHESS). He conducted his thesis as a young researcher at the National Institute of Demographic Studies (INED) on the issues of development economics. He then served as political advisor at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, in charge of monitoring France's international development policy in the field of reproductive, maternal and child health. He was then appointed diplomatic advisor to the Minister of Families, Children and Women's Rights.
